

COL McMillen begins his interview recounting his experiences as the commander of the 113th Support Battalion deployed during Operation Enduring Freedom (OEF) from May 2004 thru July 2005. He details how his unit received attachments for performing postal, finance and security escort missions as part of Task Force Phoenix based in Kabul, Afghanistan. COL McMillen describes the Leader Development and Education for a Sustained Peace (LDESP) program as particularly useful in understanding the Afghanistan operating environment. In the second portion of his interview, COL McMillen focuses on his experiences as the Agribusiness Officer in Charge of the 2-19th Agribusiness Development Team (ADT) mobilized in support of OEF. COL McMillen describes in detail his interactions with local agricultural extension agents and provincial officials in teaching improved agricultural techniques such as beekeeping, animal husbandry, erosion control, plant pathology, poultry management, drip irrigation and grain storage. To facilitate longer term change, McMillen partnered with the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) in starting up producer cooperatives. Later in his narrative, McMillen notes the importance of synchronizing Civil-Military coordination efforts with Non-Lethal Effects operations. He relates those undercurrents of mistrust, corruption, graft and the pull of family ties interwoven in Afghani culture. McMillen describes the lack of a barn-raising cooperative spirit which inhibited the effectiveness of cooperatives, and the lack of Afghan infrastructure (electricity, telephone and Internet) which hindered cross communication among the Afghan populace. In closing, COL McMillen stressed the particular importance of finding interpreters with specific agriculture experience. This item ships from La Vergne, TN. Paperback.
